If you have not participated before, you need an artist's number.

*** Please bring inventory sheets, which list each of your items with an inventory number and price. Please **keep a copy** of these sheets for your records. Tags on pieces for sale should have your artist's number, inventory number, and price. If you don't have an artist's number, one will be issued to you upon receiving your application. You must mark all tags with these numbers or risk not getting paid for a sold item.

B. ☐ I am entering the **Art Show ..** Members - \$15.00 for first 1 to 3 pieces. If you are only entering 1 or 2 pieces, the price is still \$15.00. If you want to enter more then three pieces, another \$5.00 for each extra piece will be charged. Just remember that this is the ART part of the show and pieces will be judged according to artfulness. **Art Show** pieces will be juried in for Artistry, Craftsmanship, Originality, and Cleanliness on delivery day. Only your original art please! No entries from published patterns. and no pieces that you have not completely produced yourself. If a collaboration. please list all contributors. See below for definitions of categories. Please have pieces ready for hanging from a grid (hooks used), from the pipes (on chain, preferability), or from our metal stand. Please do not bring you own stand for hanging pieces unless cleared by Deborah first. Have appropriate hooks on these pieces. If the piece is a sculpture, bowl, etc. (that will sit on a table), please have display stands with your piece. This includes jewelry. Pieces will not be displayed if stands are not with the piece (for display). Remember, pieces may not be seen if laying flat. Also, you need to state whether the stands are included in the price of the piece This is especially important in the gift section as well. Do NOT tape a lot of papers to the back of your pieces.

CATEGORIES:

Hot: Includes all works that start out hot and stay hot while being created. (furnace, torch work, hot casting, lost wax, etc.)

Warm: Includes all kiln works that start out cold and then get warm (1600 max) in a kiln (fusing, cold casting, slumping, draping, pate-de-verre, freeze and fuse, etc.)

Cold: Includes all works that are produced while the glass is cold (flat panels (leaded and copper foiled), sand carving, etching, leaded lamps, leaded boxes, mosaic, etc.)

Mixed technique: Includes all works that are a combination of two or more categories (technique).

**** If there is a question about the correct category, please feel free to ask on the day of delivery. Works must be, at least 50% glass.

Wearable Art - Any work that is wearable,, but not limited to, jewelry.

MONDAY – FRIDAY	10:00AM until 6:00PM
SATURDAY	9:00AM until 6:00PM
SUNDAY	10:00AM until 5:00PM.

REQUIRED PARTICIPATION:

Please sign up for at least two shifts during the show, and be present for installing and removing the show.

TIME REQUIREMENTS:

Each participant must help set-up and takedown. All Participants must pitch in and do this together, and not expect to leave it to "others" – your fellow artists!

There is a specified time for these events and it is expected that you will honor your commitments to make this show a success.

Each participant is required to volunteer their time (at least 2 half day shifts) working as show hosts and sales people. You will be trained in how to do sales. You may bring work at anytime to replace sold items in the gift gallery.

CALENDAR:

Set-up - Thursday, November 6 - set up show, tables, lighting, and check-in of artwork. **All participants are expected to help with setting up all of the equipment unless you have a valid excuse.**

Subs will be ordered at lunchtime. No setting up your table display until all of the equipment is set up and hooked up (around noon time).

Judging, set-up and soft opening (1:00) - Friday - November 7th

Opening and awards party - Saturday - November 8th

Show ends. Pick up and take down all work - Sunday, November 16th

Take down can start at 3:30PM but not before. We will be closing at 3:30 this day in order to give more time to take down. All artwork must be taken down on this day. You

have until the closing of the Gardens at 5:00 to pick up your things and clean your area. We have to be out of there by 5:00PM. **All participants must help with knocking down the show and packing up the equipment.** Need volunteers helping Mike pack up the truck and unpacking it to store.

Final takedown and pack up - Monday, November 17th at 10:00AM (usually, we try not to get to this point.)

PLEASE BE AWARE OF THE TIMES THE GARDENS IS OPEN AS WE NEED TO OPEN AND CLOSE EACH DAY USING THOSE TIMES.
